

AIIB Q4 2020 Report on the Policy on Public Information

This report summarizes the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank's (AIIB or the Bank) information disclosure practices as required by the <u>Policy on Public Information</u> and its <u>Directive</u> during the period from Oct.1 to Dec. 31, 2020.

The report is divided into three sections. First, it looks at AIIB's practices in proactive disclosure. Second, it provides an overview of AIIB's responses to information requests. Third, it covers the Bank's engagement with other MDBs on information disclosure.





AIIB discloses information on investment projects supported by its COVID-19 Crisis Recovery Facility (CRF) in accordance with the paper on the decision to support the Crisis Recovery Facility.

In the case of a policy-based lending (PBL) and a development policy financing (DPF) cofinanced with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) or the World Bank, a nondisclosed Memorandum of the President (MoP) is used in place of a Project Document. AIIB discloses information on the operation via the PSI. For liquidity support and PBLs and DPFs that support policy actions taken by the beneficiary government, and are not targeted to specific investments, client environmental and social documentation disclosure requirements do not apply.

Figure 1. Number of Requests Received by Month, Q4 2020




Figure 2 shows the requests per respective category for Q4 2020. Project and career opportunities were among the top categories.




Figure 2. Requests Per Category, Q4 2020

Figure 5 shows the locations of the requesters. China, UK and Afghanistan were the top three origins of requests.




Figure 3. Top 10 Locations of Requesters, Q4 2020




Figure 4. Requesters' Professional Background, Q4 2020

Figure 4 shows the professional background of the requesters. Requesters from academia, financing and consulting composed the top three largest groups.
