Assignment Title: Consultancy Services for Resettlement Plan and Indigenous Peoples Plan Implementation Agency (NGO) for “Improvement of roads within Imphal city with rigid pavement including concrete lined drains”

Reference No.: MUR-CS-04

The Government of India has applied for financing from the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) toward the cost of the Manipur Urban Road, Drainage and Asset Management Improvement Project (MURDAMIP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include:

The NGO shall be responsible for assisting the Employer in facilitating the process of Land Acquisition and implementation of Resettlement Plan (RP) & Indigenous Peoples Plan (IPP) in an efficient and transparent manner. These activities shall comply with the AIIB’s Environmental and Social Framework (ESF) and all relevant National & State laws/acts pertinent to safeguarding general public including indigenous people, who are termed as Scheduled Tribe in Indian context. The NGO shall also be responsible for implementation of all Action Plans (AP) prepared as part of RP covering the social aspects of the project such as Stakeholder Engagement Plan (SEP), Gender Action Plan (GAP) and Labour Management Plan (LMP) and any other relevant Action Plan. The NGO shall also support the Employer in proper functioning of grievance redressal mechanism (GRM) at all levels and conducting awareness / disclosure programs & skill development / institutional training programs through liaising with appropriate authorities including government departments, institutions, etc.

The NGO shall be engaged for a period of three (3) years and one & a half (1.5) months i.e., three (3) years of construction period + one & a half (1.5) months prior to construction period. The assignment is expected to commence by 1st quarter of 2025.

The Externally Aided Projects, Public Works Department Manipur now invites eligible NGO to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested NGO should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The shortlisting criteria are:

i. Management Competence –

- a. *Project Management Coordination*: Availability of permanent key staff of the NGO (Registered under Societies Registration Act) in the form of permanent management staff and key experts in the field of Resettlement and Rehabilitation.
- b. *Approach and Methodology*: Methodology for implementation of Resettlement Plan and Indigenous Peoples Plan Implementation.

ii. Technical Competence –

- a. *NGO's specialization vis à vis the sectoral focus of the assignment*: NGO's general experience in projects in the field of Resettlement & Rehabilitation.
- b. *NGO's experience vis à vis the assignment's TOR*: NGO's specific experience in road projects in the field of Resettlement & Rehabilitation.

iii. Geographical Competence

- a. *NGO's regional experience*: NGO's experience in projects in the Himalayan Region specifically in the North East region of the Country.
- b. *Permanent presence/ local presence*: NGO or its association having local office is preferable.

In case of a Joint Venture (JV) all the JV partners are required to submit experiences and other competence requirements separately

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section II, paragraphs, 4.4, 4.4.2 and 4.4.3 of the AIIB's "Procurement Instructions for Recipients" June 2, 2016 ("PIR"), setting forth the AIIB's policy on conflict of interest.

NGO's/NGO may associate with other NGO to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

The NGO will be selected in accordance with Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in PIR with 80:20 of weightage of Technical & Financial Points.

The submission of the NGO on the EOI should be limited to 10 pages for Sole Firm and 20 pages for Joint Venture (JV) firms with minimum font size of 11.
